ILEP is offering 6 places for fully registered current teachers of Japanese (Years 1-13) in New Zealand to attend a two- week language and cultural immersion programme in September/October 2016 at the Japan Foundation Centre in Kansai, Japan.

Course Content:

- Sessions on Japanese culture
- Introduction of Japanese teaching materials/language and culture resources
- Activity based PD: includes orienteering, homestay, school visit

Selection Priorities:

- An intermediate level of Japanese equivalent to JLPT Level N5 or above
- Evidence of a strong commitment to on-going professional learning
- Demonstrated contribution to the Japanese language teaching community
- Teach students in Years 7-10
